PRACTICUM EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS: Practicum experience placements are arranged locally in a community agency during the second and third academic years of the program. Each student has two placements and concurrent enrollment in practice courses during the course of study. Each placement involves 500 hours of field work, with a total of 1000 hours completed to fulfill degree requirements. Students complete 16 hours of practicum experience each week between the months of September and May. Practicum experience hours are completed through either two 8-hour weekdays or one 8-hour weekday and two 4-hour weekday periods.
