PK-3 Early Childhood Education Specialist Instruction Credential Program (ECECP)

The PK-3 ECECP is a 46-unit program. Teacher Candidates complete program prerequisites (and may take any or all corequisites) and demonstrate subject matter competence when applying to the program. Candidates complete all five subject-specific pedagogy courses with a “B” or better when applying to Student Teaching. Candidates who may seek additional subject-specific content support, such as in math or science, will be provided with a list of recommended content courses.
