We further recognize the need to reduce the globar mission of greenhouse gases by 80% by ore indury at the latest, in order to avert the worst impacts of global warming and to reestablish the more stable climatic conditions that have made human progress over the last 10,000 years possible, and
- Whereas, we understand that there might be **short** challenges associated with this effort, we believe that there will be great short edium, and longterm economic, health, social and environmental benefits, including achieving energy independence for the U.**3**s quickly as possible, and
- Whereas, we believe colleges and universities must exercise leadership in their communities and throughout society by modeling ways to minimize global warming emissions, and by providing the knowledge and the educated graduate
